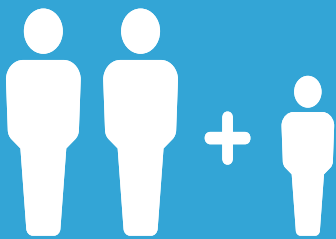
Any interaction with children and young people (under 18 years of age) via a social media platform is to be facilitated with parent permission.

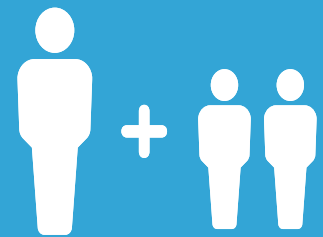
Parent/Carer Consent Form
